

Community Relations

Complaints Concerning Schools or School Districts

When a complaint is made about a school or a school district, it shall be the policy of the Inyo County Office of Education to tell the person(s) that the problem should be presented to the teacher, principal, the superintendent (if one) and to the district governing board.

If all these avenues are complied with, and the complaint does not resolve itself, then the County Superintendent, or his designee, will attempt to assist in resolving the problem.

In no way does the Office of Education want to run the affairs of a district.
