Public Hearing on Proposed Budget

On or before July 1, the county office shall hold a public hearing on the proposed budget for the purpose of allowing the board and/or public to object to the proposal or any item in the budget. The budget hearing will be concluded on the proposed budget when there are no requests for hearing, and the final adoption of the budget shall not take place until the hearing is concluded.

The agenda for that hearing shall include the time, place, and the purpose of the public hearing, and such other information as may be determined by the county board, and shall state that any taxpayer directly affected by the county school service fund budget may appear before the board and speak to the proposed budget or any item therein.

Following the public hearing, the final budget shall be adopted by the county board and filed with the Superintendent of Public Instruction, the county board of supervisors and the county auditor.
