The superintendent, business manager, and/or caretaker is directed to set up an operations and maintenance program which will ensure proper care, protection and improvement of the county office facilities. The county board requests the cooperation of pupils, teachers and administrators in support of the custodians and maintenance personnel in carrying out such a program.
