



Students – Regional Occupational Programs

ADMISSION

1. Students of the school districts served by the Regional Occupational Program and other county office operated programs shall be admitted according to the provisions of California Education Code. Admission of students to the Inyo County Office of Education Regional Occupational Program is limited to pupils whose attendance can be credited to the Regional Occupational Program.
2. Students of other county operated programs and students of the school districts served by the Regional Occupational Program shall have priority over non-public school students and adults.
3. Enrollment in the Regional Occupational Program that exceeds state-funded cap must be approved by the County Superintendent.
4. Students not enrolled in school districts served by the county Regional Occupational Program or in county office of education programs may only be enrolled in the Regional Occupational Program if:
 - a. They are 16 years of age; or they are in 11th or 12th grade. (To be considered an 11th or 12th grader, the student must have credits equal to an 11th or 12th grader of the regular school.)
 - b. There is space in the particular class as determined by the Regional Occupational Program Director.
 - c. The site rules, policies and practices that govern behavior, grading, attendance, etc. that apply to regular students will apply to students enrolled per Section 4 of this policy.
6. Adults may be enrolled in the Regional Occupational according to the provisions of California Education Code.
