Reporting to Parents

The county board believes that good communication between parent/guardian and teacher is important in the educational process. Reporting contacts between parent/guardian and teacher should be varied and frequent, and all appropriate forms of communication should be frequent, and all appropriate forms of communication should be utilized, including parent-teacher conferences, mail, telephone, and school visitation by parents.

Students who are on an individualized education program are to be evaluated regularly, and the evaluations shall be communicated to the parents according to the regulations and procedures of the Inyo County Special Education Service Region.
