Instructional Support Services

The superintendent, or his/her designee, shall establish procedures for the operation of the Instructional Materials Center (IMC) at the county office of education. These procedures shall address the following activities: (a) equipment and materials selection; (b) equipment and materials circulation; (c) challenged materials; and (d) distribution and use of materials for sex education and venereal disease instruction.

Contract usage fees shall be established by the superintendent in accordance with Education Code Section 1830(b).
