

Instruction

Vocational-Industrial Education

The Regional Occupational Program shall be an integral part of the secondary instructional curriculum. The program shall provide instruction and services which shall give graduates an opportunity to attain entry level employment skills in occupational areas of their choice. Program planning shall consider student needs and current labor market trends. (Education Code Section 51228(b)).

The county board shall annually review and assess the participation of 11th and 12th grade students in regional occupational centers and programs. The superintendent, Director of ROP, Vocational Ed and district superintendents shall formulate an annual plan to increase the number of students in the program. (Education Code Section 52304.1.)
