County Advisory Committee

The Inyo County Curriculum Advisory Committee shall be composed of seven appointed members - four professional and three lay members from various sections of the County. The professionals consist of one County Office staff member, one District Superintendent, and two teachers. Other professionals may be invited to advise the committee because of their expertise, but shall not have a vote. The committee shall advise the Superintendent of Schools in the following areas:

1. Review, evaluate and implement the Course of Study adopted for the County schools.
2. Understand the functions of the State Instructional Materials Display Center (IMDC) and plan for and implement County-wide involvement in the adoption and the evaluation of the IMDC materials.
3. Renew and recommend for approval motion pictures, instructional materials and library book acquisition for the County Instructional Media Center.

The guidelines are as follows:

- The recommendations of the committee are advisory only.
- The committee will meet on a monthly basis during the school year.
- The committee will elect from its ranks a chairperson and a secretary.
- Terms of office:

The initial committee member appointments shall be as follows:

Two (2) professional members and one (1) lay member - 1 year term
Two (2) professional members and two (2) lay members - 2 year term
Subsequent appointments shall be for an unexpired term or for 2 years.
