Site Development

The county board and superintendent believe that site selection and development should start from the premise that county office buildings are an integral and inseparable part of the total community. Since the county office of education is a community institution, it should reflect this relationship physically as well as ideologically.

The manner and extent to which a site serves the county office's educational needs should be considered as only one aspect of its adequacy. Its adequacy should also be appraised in respect to its potential for contributing to the scope and depth of many other cultural functions in the community.

The process of site selection concerns the entire administrative and supervisory staffs and others with special skills and insights. The superintendent and the county board, therefore, shall establish such criteria and procedures as are necessary to assure the citizens and other governmental agencies that the best possible sites are being acquired for the least expenditure of public funds.
