Non-Use of Facilities

The following types of activities are not to be permitted in the educational facilities under the control of the County Superintendent of Schools:

1. Activities promulgating any theory or doctrine subversive to the laws of the United States or any political subdivision thereof, or advocating governmental change by violence.
2. Activities which are inconsistent with the uses of the building and interfere with the regular conduct of work.
3. Activities that may violate the canons of good morals, manners, or taste, or may be injurious to the buildings, grounds or equipment.
4. Activities that are strictly commercial advertising.
5. Activities that are for fund raising, except when permitted by special permission.
6. Activities that are discriminatory in the legal sense.
7. Activities which constitute a monopoly for the benefit of any person or organization.
