

Bylaws of the Board

Composition and Trustee Areas

The County Committee on School District Organization conducted a study on trustee areas following the 1990 census. They recommended the following policy which has been adopted by the County Board of Education in January 1992.

County Board trustee areas will conform to the districts of the Inyo County Board of Supervisors as they existed prior to the 1990 census. It was determined by the County Committee, and affirmed by the County Board of Education, that the needs of all the school districts, and especially Death Valley due to its geographic isolation, would be better served in this fashion.

A complete set of maps and written legal boundaries of the trustee areas are on file at the County Office of Education.

Members shall be elected by the electors in the trustee areas as follows:

- Area I - Round Valley and Bishop (north), one member
- Area II - Bishop (east), one member
- Area III - Bishop (south & west), one member
- Area IV - Big Pine, Independence and Lone Pine, one member
- Area V - Lone Pine and Death Valley, one member

Composition and Trustee Areas

County board trustee areas will conform to the districts of the Inyo County Board of Supervisors and, in the future, will change in accordance with redistricting affecting the Board of Supervisors.

The only exception to the Supervisorial Districts will be in Trustee Areas II and III. These districts will be combined, with two representatives elected from anywhere within these boundaries. This will allow for greater flexibility in recruitment as well as broader representation for the voters.

Members shall be elected by the electors in the trustee areas as follows:

- Area I - Round Valley and Bishop, one member
- Area II & III - Bishop and Big Pine, two members
- Area IV - Big Pine, Independence and Lone Pine, one member
- Area V - Lone Pine and Death Valley, one member
