

Bylaws of the Board

Development in Service

All board members are encouraged to participate in professional development activities designed for them in order to perform their responsibilities to the state, to the electorate and to the county office.

Attendance at Meetings, Institutes, Conventions

Board members are encouraged to participate in county board and related workshops sponsored by local, state and national educational associations. Attendance at meetings directly or indirectly related to education or county office matters shall be encouraged for the values they have to the district and the in-service growth of county board members.

The superintendent shall be notified of all such meetings to be attended by county board members.

Board members will be requested to report back to the board with information of interest acquired at the various meetings and workshops. Funds for participation at such meetings will be budgeted for annually. Reimbursement of board members for their travel and conference/workshop expenses will be in accordance with board policy.
