

Bylaws of the Board

Methods of Operation

The county board has the power of establishing its own procedures.

The county board shall concern itself primarily with broad questions of policy, rather than with administrative details. The application of policies is an administrative task to be performed by the superintendent and the superintendent's staff, who shall be held responsible for the effective administration and supervision of the county office.

All actions of the county board shall be taken only in official county board meetings called, scheduled and conducted according to these bylaws and the statutes of the state.
