

**Bylaws of the Board**

**COMPENSATION/TRAVEL EXPENSES**

Each member of the board is entitled to receive \$160.00 per month stipend for attending the regularly scheduled monthly board meetings.

The county board may allow the current federal/state approved rate per mile in the discharge of duties as a board member. Mileage shall be calculated from the town of legal residence to the place of meeting and return. Travel reimbursement, other than from legal residence to regular or special board meetings, shall require prior approval of the board.

In case of emergency or severe weather conditions at the time of a board meeting, lodging and meal expenses will be allowed for county board members.

Lodging and meal allowance will be provided to county board members attending regular or special meetings in Death Valley, if appropriate. Meals and lodging shall be allowed for the member from Death Valley when traveling to county board meetings.

The County Board of Education may designate one or more of its members to represent the Board at appropriate conferences relating to Board responsibilities. Such attendance may be counted in lieu of attendance at Board meetings held during the time of the conference.

Members so designated will receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses for meals, lodging and transportation. Mileage shall be reimbursed at the current federal/state approved rate per mile for use of a private automobile. See Board Policy#4133.1/4233.1 regarding the reimbursement rate for private aircraft usage. Compensation shall be payable from the county schools service fund.
